第一天 新加坡 → 高雄 晚: 机上用餐 | 赠送小蛋糕+饮料每人一份
在新加坡樟宜机场集合, 搭乘航班飞往高雄。抵达台湾后回到饭店休息, 期待明日开始的台湾之旅。**航班: (SIN-KHN CI758 1810/2230)**

第二天 高雄 - 嘉义 早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 台湾料理 | 晚: 夜市自理
佛光山位于台湾高雄市大树区, 2011年落成。1998年星云大师至印度菩提伽耶传授国际三坛大戒, 当时西藏喇嘛贡嘎多杰仁波切, 感念佛光山长期促进世界佛教汉藏文化交流, 是弘扬人间佛教的正信道场, 遂表达赠送珍藏近30年的佛牙舍利心愿。星云大师为此珍贵的宗教遗产而建馆至今, 秉持「以人为本」推动社会终身教育, 是综合性最强并极具特色的博物馆。**驳二艺术特区**-被历史尘封的陈旧仓库, 时光凝滞了种种发展迹象, 因为艺术文化的呼声被解放, 不断注入创意灵感而重获新生, 日渐茁壮。**栈贰库**-高雄港边的文创栈贰库, 全台唯一的白色旋转木马坐落于此, 一旁的白色气球飞轮可载游客升空赏海景, 纯白色系让许多少女心大喷发, 如今是港边最受瞩目的打卡地标, 白天夜晚都好拍, 而海风吹起来是甜甜的滋味。**安平古堡**(又称热兰遮城)是台南市的一座古堡, 其历史可追溯至荷兰统治台湾的时期。**亿载金城**是一座红色四墙城堡, 四周有堡垒和护城河。在古代, 中间的那条草皮是士兵们进行军事演习的地方, 从地图上看, 可以明显看出, 它是比例特别均匀的菱形设计, 如今已成为热门的旅游目的地。**延平郡王祠**为台湾超过百座以上主祀郑成功的庙宇中, 唯一由官方兴建纪念郑成功的专祠, 日治时期曾改名为开山神社, 也是日人在台最早设置的神社, 更是二次大战前日本海外神社中唯一从庙宇改为神社的特例。今晚在**嘉义文化路夜市**享受台湾当地小吃。

第三天 嘉义 - 南投 早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 阿里山风味餐 | 晚: 中华料理
阿里山森林游乐区(含小火车+神木区+姊妹潭+受镇宫)闻名国际的阿里山神木屹立三千年, 历经风霜后, 内部早已因受到电击而焦黑, 林务局在1998年忍痛解开固定在枝干上的钢索, 让大神木倒下回归自然, 结束它传奇的一生。目前在山区取而代之的古老景观则是森林神木与巨木群栈道。**探索茶园**-阿里山因日照短、温差大再加上山泉灌溉造就出闻名遐迩的阿里山高山茶。茶园的景色更是美不胜收, 地形高低起伏、茶园错落有致沿途茶香弥漫山岚、云海为伴下瞭望群山间的大片茶园令人心旷神怡。

第四天 南投 - 台中 早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 瓮仔鸡料理 | 晚: 夜市自理
原住民文化推广中心稍作停留后, 续前往**日月潭风景区**(车游湖), 日月潭是全国最大的水体, 因独特的形状酷似日月而得名。**文武庙**是集文学神和战争神为一体的中国寺庙。这座寺庙有供奉战神、武神、文神和孔子的殿堂。**彩虹眷村**位于台中市, 是一个色彩鲜艳的艺术眷村, 为了不让眷村被破坏和拆迁, 一位居民将眷村粉刷涂鸦, 意外地成为游客和部落客们的主要打卡景点。今晚在台中最大的夜市-**逢甲夜市**, 尽情享受琳琅满目的服装摊位、游戏站和美食摊位。

第五天 台中 - 台北

早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 九份自理 | 晚: 怀旧料理
平溪十分老街一探当地居民的朴素生活, 在这条古色古香的老街上, 您可以在倾斜的山坡上沿着铁路两旁找到未受现代气息影响的传统民居, 每当火车经过铁路上方的街道时, 都会听到隆隆的声音。在这里您可以与旅伴一起体验点灯放天灯的简单快乐(含天灯四人一组)。**九份老街+九份观景台**这个充满悠哉、历史、古色古香的小山城! 早期盛产金矿的九份, 有「黄金山城」的美称, 聚落因采金人潮涌入而繁华, 后随淘金没落而宁静。**鹿爷爷亲子农场**(送牧草、小点心)-农场里有专人导览, 动物区有梅花鹿、水豚君, 跳跳羊, 还可以近距离接触狐獴一家。

第六天 台北

早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 火锅自助吃到饱 | 晚: 夜市自理
圆山饭店(外观)-圆山大饭店的原址, 在日治时期曾是台湾神社, 在中国式建筑上采用相当多的龙形雕刻, 也有人称圆山大饭店为『龙宫』, 除采用龙形之外, 也有石狮、梅花等中国建筑常用的图案。而后前往天禄展示中心, 后带您来到**凤梨酥观光工厂DIY**, 您可在该使用可爱的模板制作出属于自己的凤梨酥。前往**士林官邸花园**为先总统蒋中正度过26年的官邸; 士林官邸自公元1996年8月全面开放后, 成为目前台北市第一座生态公园(每月有不同的花展现)。**士林夜市**是台北市范围最大的夜市, 也是国外观光客造访台北必游的观光夜市。邻近捷运剑潭站, 占地十分宽广, 可分为两个主要范围, 一个是传统阳明戏院周边的街道, 包括大南路慈诚宫一带; 另一边则是基隆路101号重新营运的士林市场。

第七天 台北

早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 铁板烧BBQ | 晚: 夜市自理
总统府(外观)是日治时期台湾总督府。它是当时台湾的最高行政机构。作为临时总督府, 这座建筑被日本人视为殖民统治下权力的象征, 因此设计得特别用心。这座庞大而宏伟的建筑见证了台湾一个多世纪的历史。它不仅成为台北市的重要地标, 也是近代历史的体现。**榕锦时光生活园区**是台北刑务所原延续清领时期的监狱建筑, 后迁移扩建至今爱国东路、金华街一带, 并由日本近代化监狱建筑专家山下启次郎规划设计, 采用当时最新式的「宾夕凡尼亚式」建筑, 成为全台规模最大的现代化监狱之一。**国父纪念馆**位于台北市信义区北部, 包括一个大型露天广场和花园。纪念馆内部纪念海峡两岸都尊崇的中华民国国父孙中山先生的一生。尔后前往**台北101大楼**(登顶自费), 台北101曾是全世界最高的摩天大楼之一(曾于2004年12月31日至2010年1月4日间拥有「世界第一高楼」的纪录)。后带您前往**西门町**, 这里是著名的娱乐和购物区, 也是台北青年文化的圣地。您可逛街在西门红楼、西本愿寺、彩虹斑马线、西门町电影院、美国街、刺青街等, 也是IG网点喔。

第八天 桃园 → 新加坡

早: 饭店早餐 | 午: 淡水老街自理
渔人码头是淡水著名的休闲渔港。该地区设有一座可欣赏美景的人行天桥, 以及一个提供大量美食(尤其是海鲜)的码头。这里受欢迎的活动包括观赏日落、欣赏风景和品尝当地小吃。**淡水渔人码头**外围有不少浪漫的景点, 而淡水情人桥更是情侣们的最爱去处。**情人桥**的造型柔和, 呈现帆船造型, 而情人桥对面码头停泊着的大小船只, 却又别有一番情调。**淡水老街**以美食和历史氛围而闻名。它是全台湾最受欢迎和最著名的老街之一。这里的一些当地美食包括阿给、铁鸡蛋、炸鱿鱼和其他海鲜。随后前往机场, 搭乘飞机返回新加坡, 结束美好的台湾之旅。

Day1 Singapore → Kaosiung (SIN-KHH CI758 1810/2230)

D: Meal On Board | Complimentary small cake + drink per person

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and board a flight to Kaohsiung. After arriving in Taiwan, return to the hotel to rest and look forward to the trip to Taiwan starting tomorrow.

Day2 Kaosiung – Chiayi

B: Energizing Breakfast | **L:** Taiwanese Cuisine | **D:** Take Own at Nightmarket

Fo Guang Shan is a Buddhist cultural, religious and educational museum located in Dashu District, Kaohsiung, Taiwan. The museum houses one of the tooth relics of Sakyamuni Buddha, the founder of the Buddhist faith. **Pier-2**, Collision is a Driving Force It was once an abandoned and forgotten warehouse buried in history due to the move from an industrial based segment to the service sector. However, with a group of persistent artist who injected waves of creativity and inspiration into the area, the Pier-2 area was released and re-born making the region a place where tourist and locals can come together to enjoy fine art. With the collision of an old area and new fine art, Pier-2 becomes an area of new vitality and liveliness. **Kaohsiung port warehouse no.2(KW2)**– The Cultural and Creative Center on the Kaohsiung KW2 has the only white carousel decoration in Taiwan. The white balloon flywheel on the side can carry tourists into the sky to enjoy the sea view. The pure white color has made many girls' hearts burst. It is now the most popular on the harbor. **Tainan Anping Fort (aka Fort Zeelandia)** is an ancient fort in Tainan City that dates back to the Dutch rule of Taiwan. The fort sits right next to Anping Old street, making it a great place to understand Taiwan's culture and at the same time get some of the best snacking at the culinary capital of Taiwan. **Eternal Golden Fort (亿载金城)**, is a red four-walled castle surrounded by bastions and moat on all four sides. The **Yanping Prince Shrine** is a dedicated shrine in memory of Zheng Chenggong. During the Japanese occupation, it was renamed Kaishan Shrine. It was also the earliest shrine set up by the Japanese in Taiwan. It was also the only special case among Japanese overseas shrines that changed from a temple to a shrine before World War II. Enjoy Taiwanese snacks at **Chiayi Wenhua Road Night Market** tonight.

Day3 Chiayi – Nantou

B: Hotel | **L:** Alishan style meal | **D:** Chinese Cuisine

Alishan Forest Recreation Area (including Alishan Forest Train+ SACRED TREES+ Sister Lake+shouzhen palace),The world-renowned Alishan sacred tree has stood for three thousand years. After going through wind and frost, the interior has long been scorched by electric shocks. In 1998, the Forestry Bureau reluctantly untied the steel cables fixed on the branches, allowing the large sacred tree to fall back to nature, ending its legendary life. The short sunshine, large temperature difference and mountain spring irrigation in Alishan have created the famous **Alishan high mountain tea**. The scenery of the tea gardens is even more beautiful. The terrain is undulating and the tea gardens are scattered in a patchwork manner. Along the way, the fragrance of tea fills the mountains. It is refreshing to look at the large tea gardens among the mountains accompanied by the sea of clouds.

Day4 Nantou – Taichung

B: Hotel | **L:** Urn-roasted chicken cuisine | **D:** Take Own at Night market

Go to **Aborigines Center** stop for a while , Visit **Sun Moon Lake(Take our tour bus visit Sun Moon Lake)** is the largest natural lake in Taiwan and home of the aboriginal Thao tribe. **Wenwu temples** are Chinese temples that combine deities from literature and war. This temple has halls dedicated to the God of War, the Warrior God, the God of Literature, and Confucius. **Rainbow Village** is a brightly colored artistic dependents village located in Taichung, Taiwan. It was converted into a tourist destination by one of the former residents in order to save the village from destruction. The unique paintings cover almost the entire village, and has become a major spot for tourists and Instagrammers. Tonight, at the largest night market in Taichung – **Fengjia Night Market**, you can taste food shops here.

Day5 Taichung – Taipei

B: Hotel | **L:** Take own at Jiufen | **D:** Nostalgic cuisine

The **Pingxi Shifen Old Street** has an old-world atmosphere. Along both sides of the railway on the slanted hillside are traditional houses untouched by modernity. Besides, there is a lantern city where you come to fly a paper lantern into the sky with a personal message and wishes (**releasing sky lanterns in a group of four people**). **Jiufen Old Street and Jiufen Observation Deck** used to be the center of gold mining. This small village is located within hills, next to the mountains, and facing the ocean. **Grandpa Deer Parent-Child Farm** (delivery of grass and snacks) – There is a dedicated tour guide in the farm. The animal area includes sika deer, capybara, jumping sheep, and you can also get up close to the meerkat family. You can interact with the cute animals here They interact.

Day6 Taipei

B: Hotel | **L:** Hot pot all-u-can-eat | **D:** Take Own at Nightmarket

Building design of Grand Hotel–The original site of the Grand Hotel was a Taiwanese shrine during the Japanese colonial period. A lot of dragon-shaped carvings were used in Chinese-style buildings. Some people also call the Grand Hotel the "Dragon Palace". Stop at **天祿館** for a while, Then visit **Pineapple Cake Tourist Factory** , you can make pineapple cake by yourself. Visit **Chiang Kai-shek Shilin Residence** The garden is full of plums, chrysanthemums and roses favored by the Chiang couple. Flowers bloom according to season and make for a stunning view throughout much of the year. **Shilin Night Market** is the largest night market in Taipei City and a must-visit tourist night market for foreign tourists visiting Taipei. It is adjacent to MRT Jiantan Station and occupies a very wide area. It can be divided into two main areas. One is the streets around the traditional Yangming Theater, including the area around Cicheng Palace on Danan Road; the other is the re-opened No. 101 Jihe Road. Shilin Market.

Day7 Taipei

B: Hotel | **L:** BBQ | **D:** Take Own at Nightmarket

The **Presidential Office (Visiting the Building Design outside)** was the Governor-General's Office of Taiwan during the Japanese colonial period. It was the highest administrative agency in Taiwan at that time. It was originally located at the ancestral hall of the Chen and Lin surnames in Taipei City in the late Qing Dynasty. It has not only become an important landmark in Taipei City, but also the embodiment of modern history. Next, visit Pearl Exhibition Center for a while. **RongjinTime Life Park** is the original prison building of the Taipei Criminal Office that continued from the Qing Dynasty. It was later moved and expanded to the area of Aiguao East Road and Jinhua Street. Asian-style building, becoming one of the largest modern prisons in Taiwan. **National Founding Father Memorial Hall** sits in the northern part of Xinyi District of Taipei, and includes a large open square and gardens. The inside of the memorial hall commemorates the life of the founding father of the Republic of China, Sun Yat-sen, who is revered on both sides of the Taiwan Strait. In addition, the memorial hall has a performance hall, free rotating art exhibitions, and changing of the guard every hour. It is definitely a sight worth seeing on your trip to Taipei. **Taipei 101 Mall (Exclude Observatory Deck)**, Taipei 101 was one of the world's tallest skyscrapers. You can come here and enjoy high-speed elevators. **XiMenDing**, immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of this famous entertainment and shopping district, and a mecca of youth culture in Taipei. You can go shopping in Ximen Red House, Nishi Honganji Relics, Rainbow Zebra Crossing, Ximending Cinema, American Street, Tattoo Street, etc.

Day8 Taipei → Singapore (TPE-SIN CI755 1955 0040+1D)

B: Hotel | **L:** Take Own at Tamsui Old Street | **D:** Meal on Board

Fisherman's Wharf is a popular leisure fishing port in Tamsui. The area features a pedestrian bridge with great views, and a long pier with tons of food options, especially seafood. **Tamsui Lover's Bridge** is a favored place for couples in love. The soft-toned Lover's Bridge features a sailboat shape, whereas the different sized boats berthed at the wharf opposite to the Lover's Bridge offer an alternative sentiment. **Tamsui Old Street** is famous for its delicious food and historical atmosphere. It is one of the most popular and well known old streets in all of Taiwan. Some local delicacies here include A-gei, iron eggs, fried squid, and other seafood. Then go to the airport and take a flight back to Singapore, ending your wonderful trip to Taiwan.
